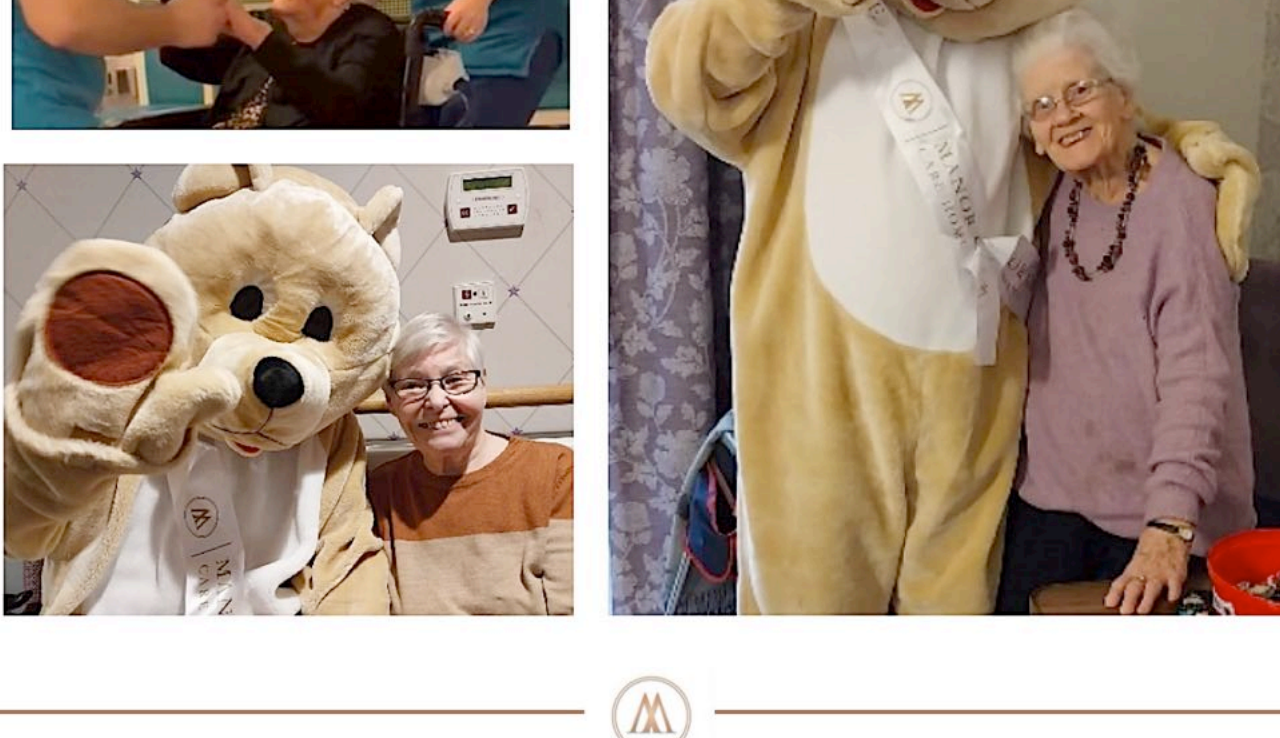
Happy New Year

Haggis, Neeps & Tatties

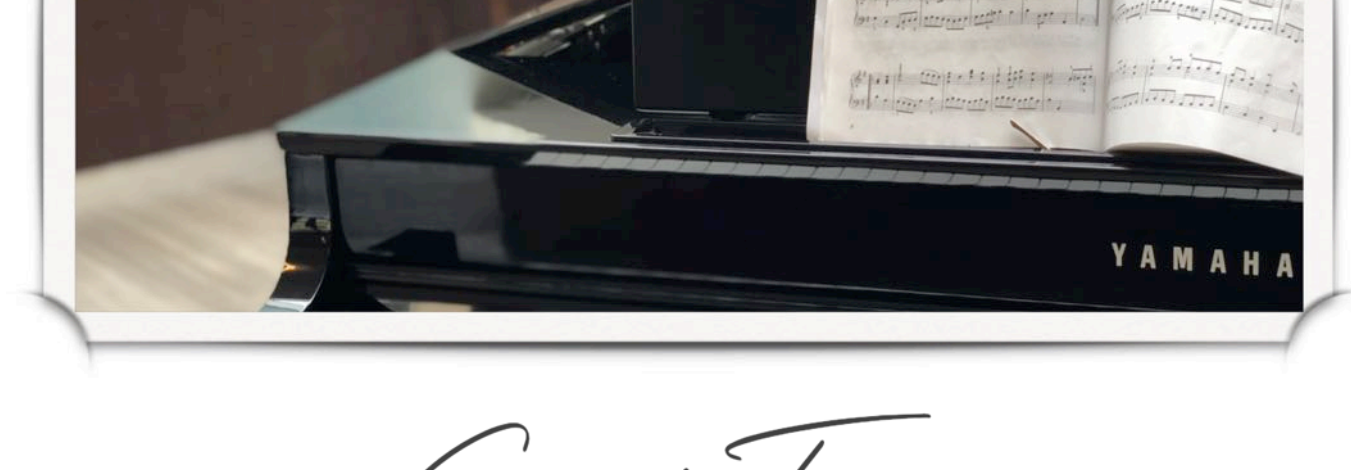

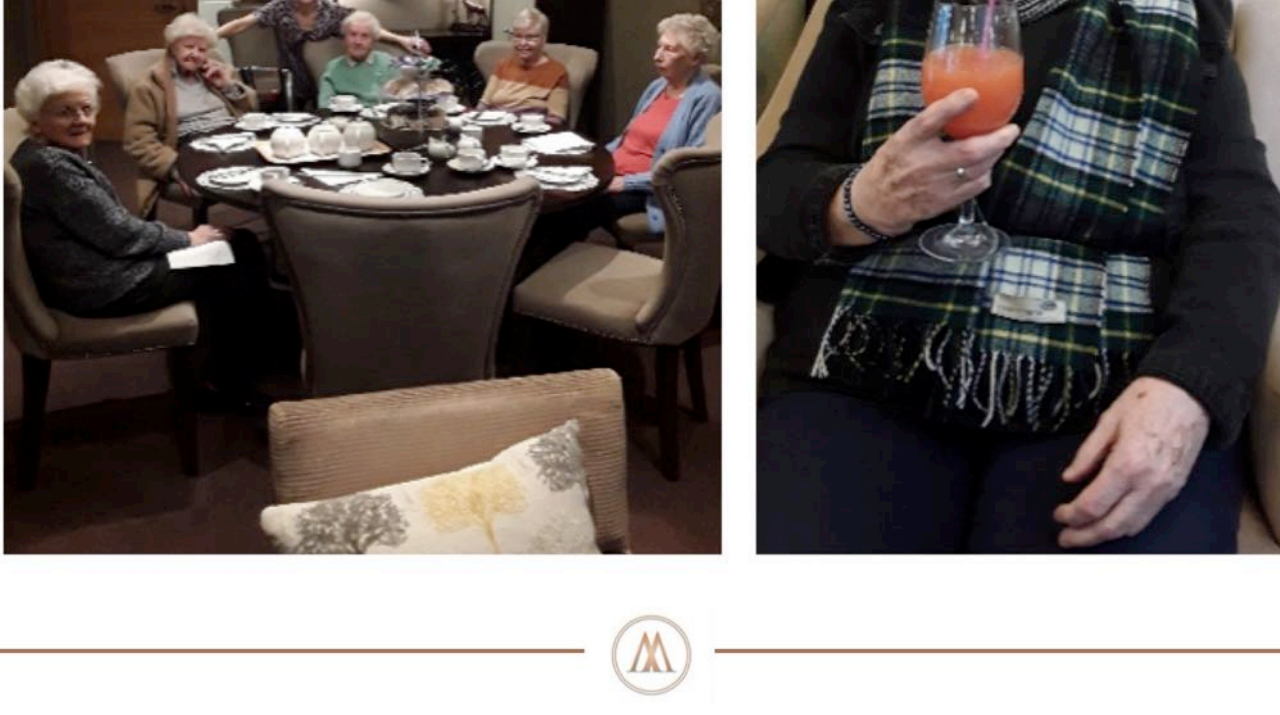


Good Times

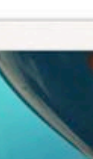

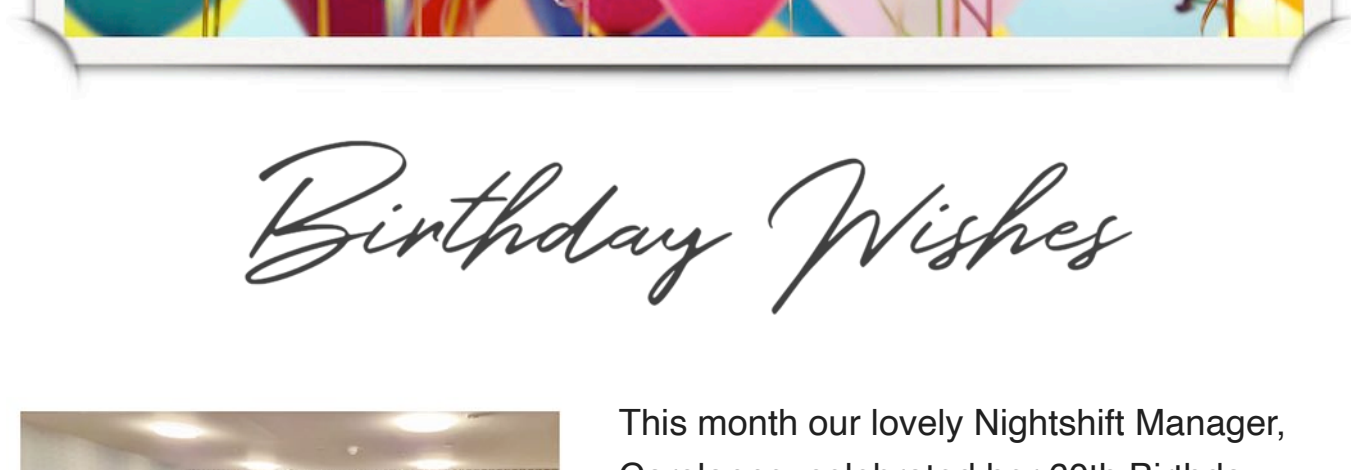
A Warm Welcome

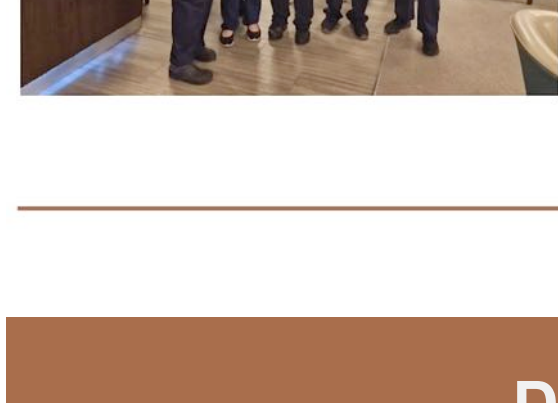
He is looking forward to being able to put into practice his previously gained IT and Admin expertise within his new role.

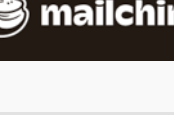
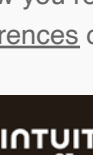
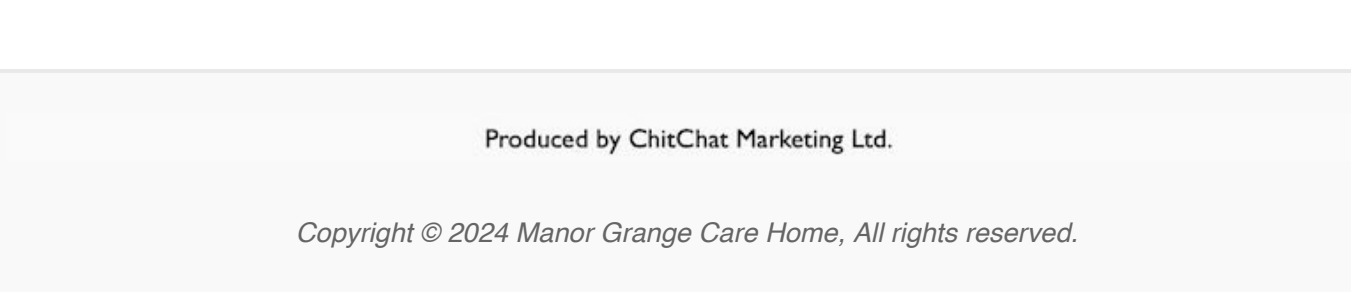
