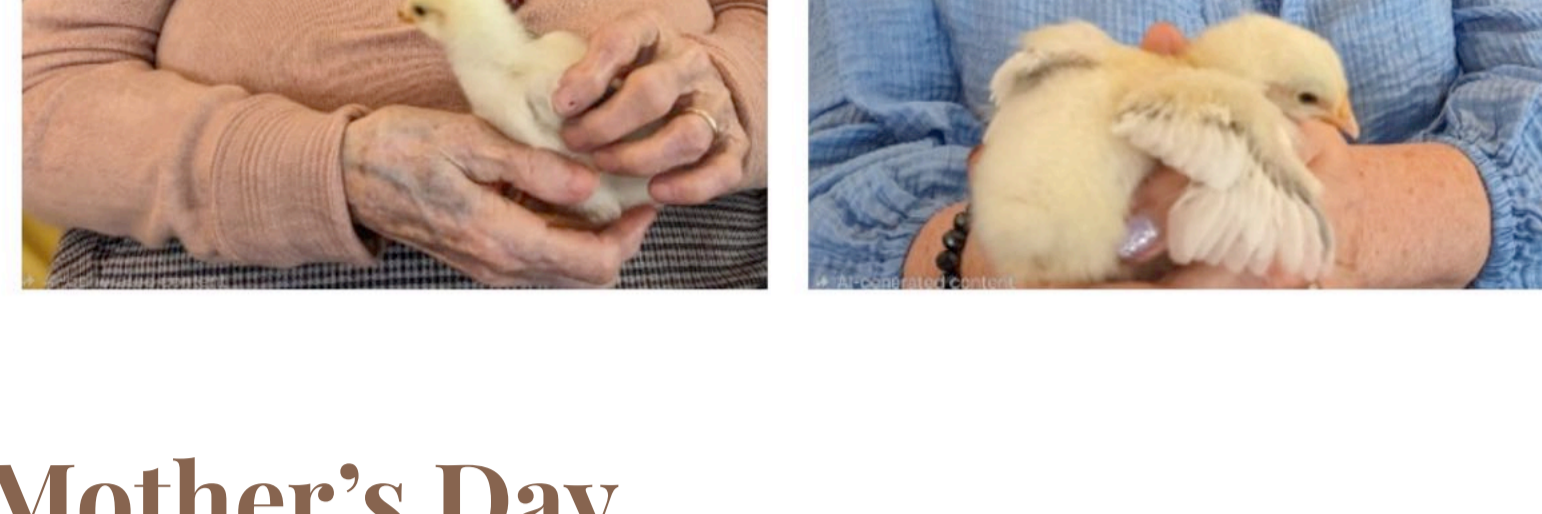
ACTIVITIES & EVENTS

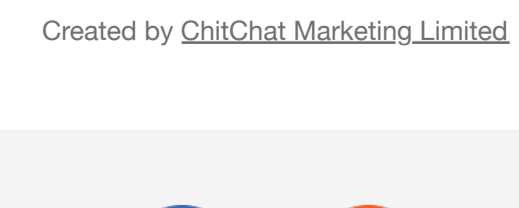

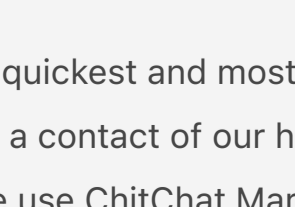
