Thank you for your continued support of the home and the team.

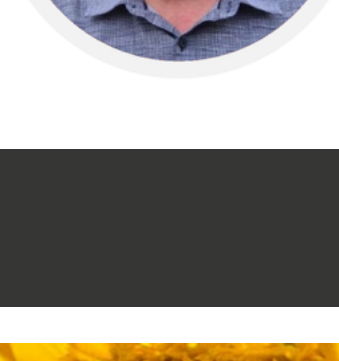

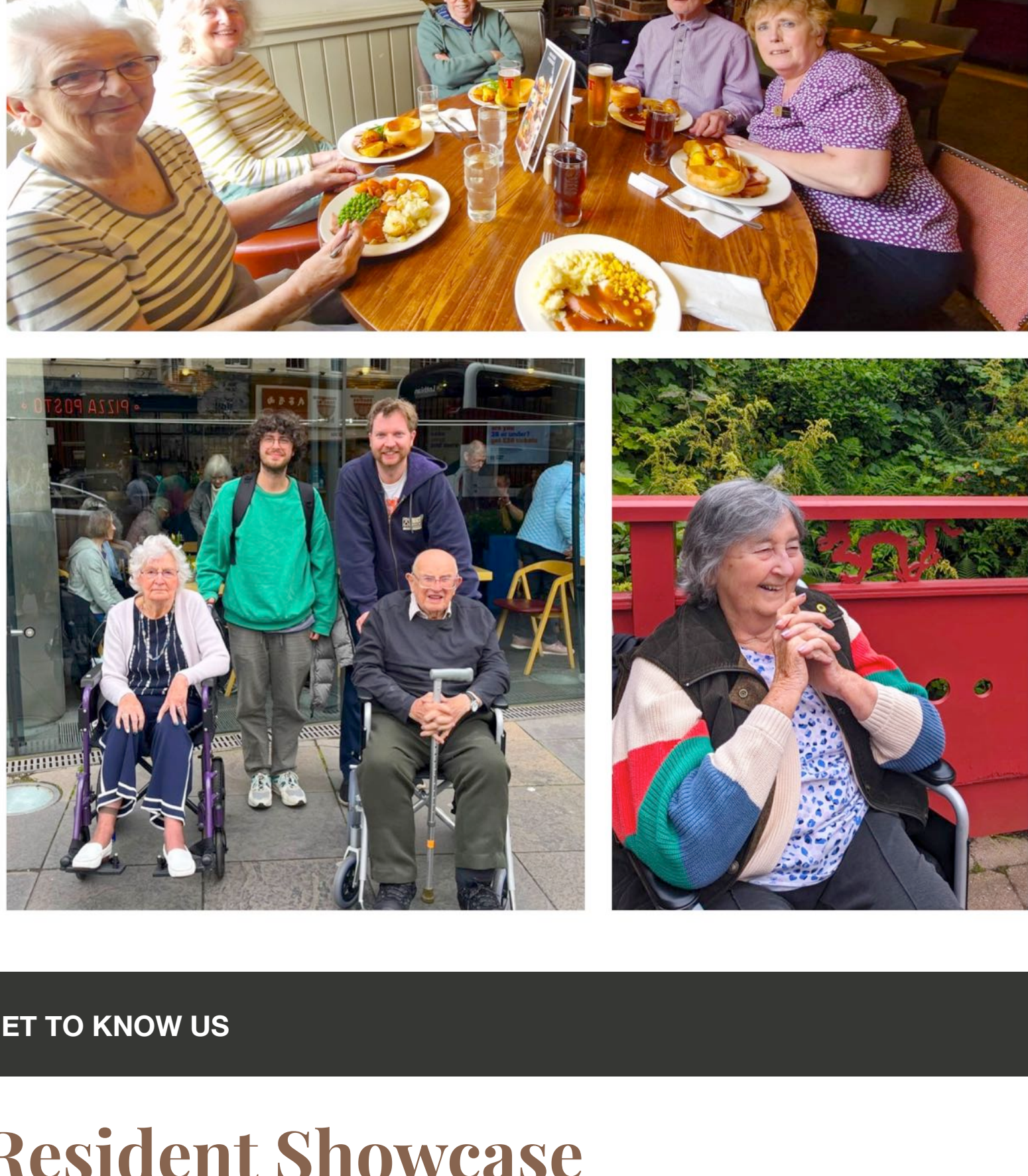
Out & About

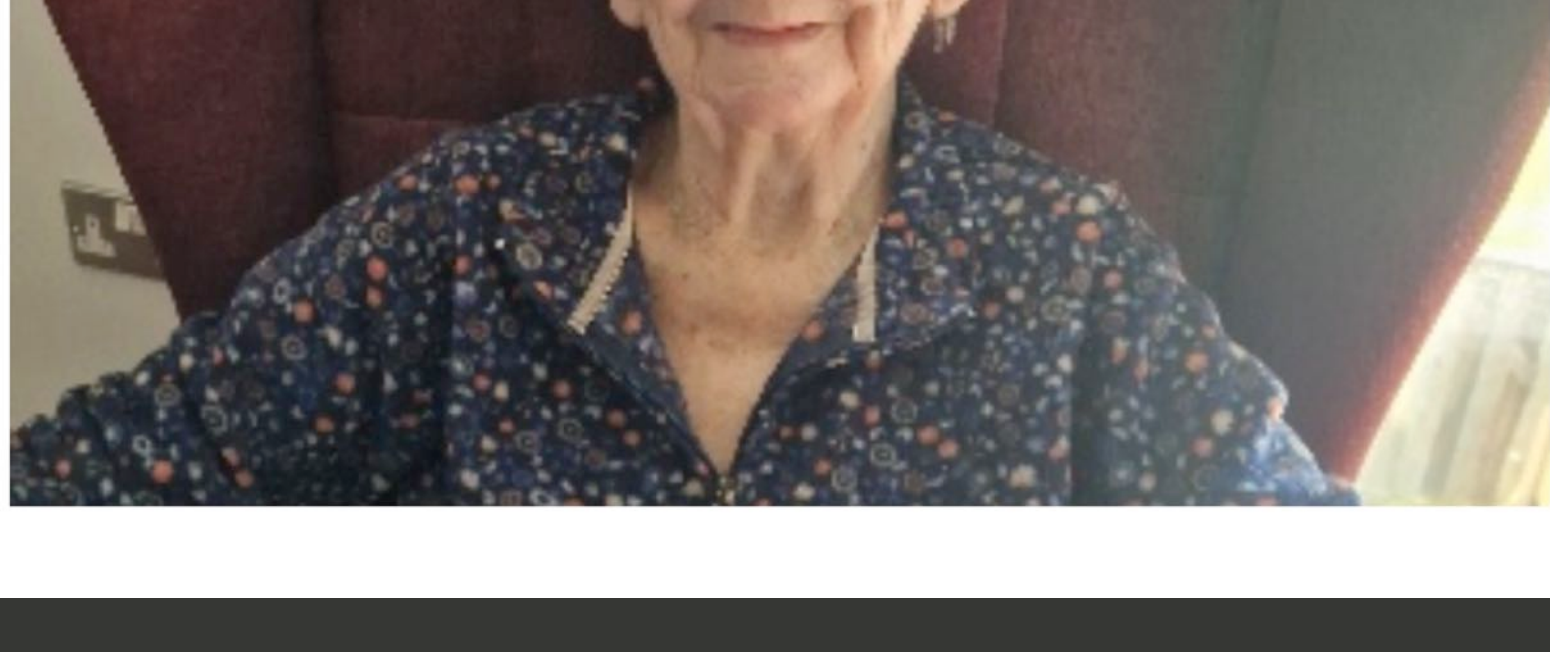
Resident Showcase

Award winning Care Home with Award Winning Staff

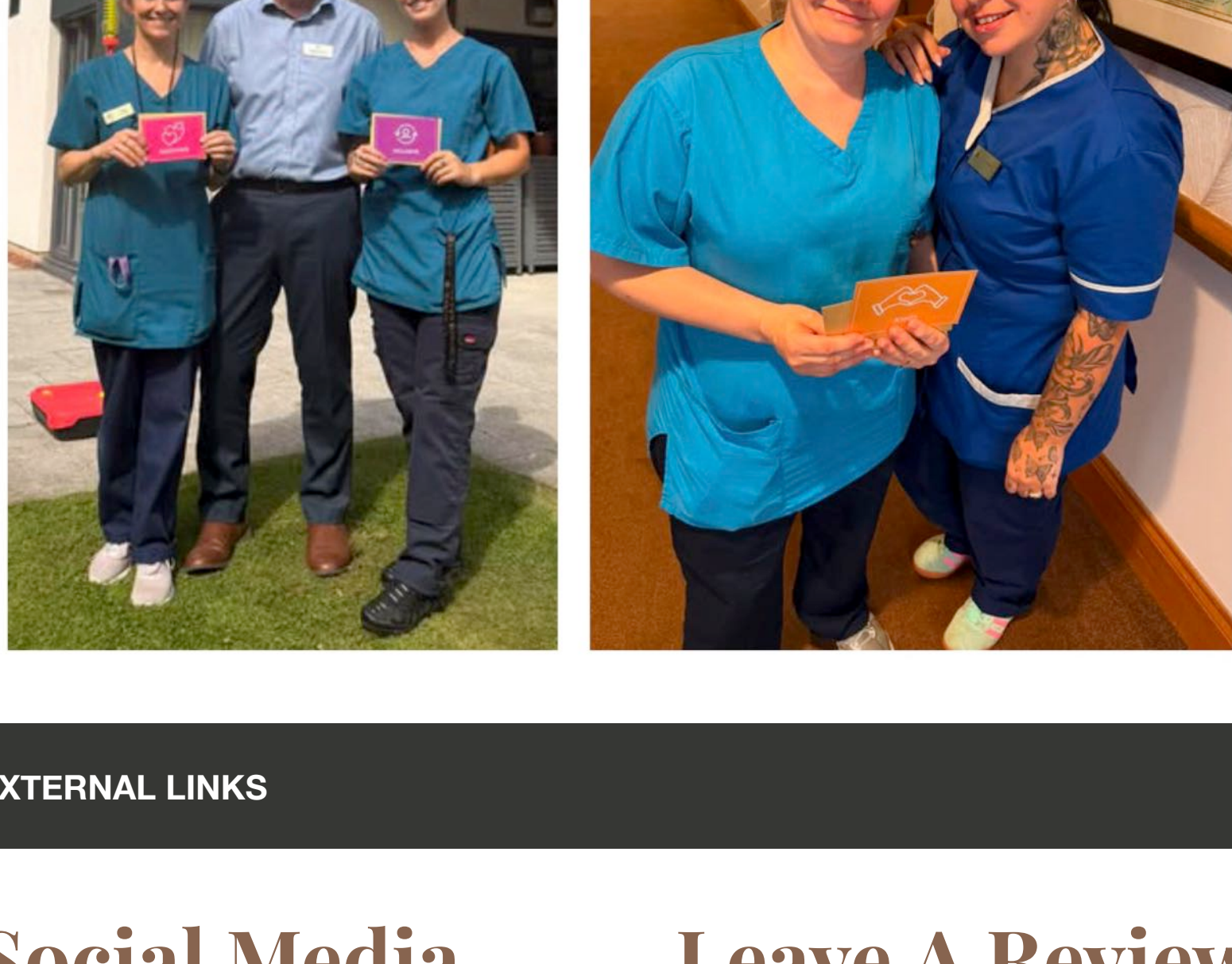
Manor Grange was extremely proud to win Lotties award for being one of the Top 100 Care Homes in the UK.
